The Willa Mae Wolfe Community Service Scholarship was established by the Franklin Township Civic League in 1998. The Scholarship is awarded each year to a Franklin Township resident who is a graduating high school senior to assist with the costs of continuing education. This includes vocational institutions.

- 1) The primary qualifying requirement for the scholarship is volunteer participation in the community.
- 2) Volunteer activities not related to sports or academic activities are more heavily weighted for consideration.
- 3) Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of "C", or the equivalent, in order to be considered and must provide a transcript of the most recently completed grading period to verify current academic standing.
- 4) Letters of recommendation may be included with the application.
- 5) Additional sheets may be attached to describe volunteer activities or provide additional information.
